

## **EPA-METHANE EMISSIONS REDUCTION ON TRIBAL LANDS** GRANT

Tribuguent (non-profit) is spearheading an initiative to secure \$50,000,000 in funding specifically to reduce methane emissions from marginal conventional wells and other oil and gas assets on tribal lands in Oklahoma. This project is part of the DE-FOA-0003256 grant under the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) – Methane Emissions Reduction Program. We are seeking support and collaboration from tribal nations, industry partners, and universities.

#### **Collaboration**


